We look forward to welcoming you to Christchurch New Zealand for the ISAR conference which will be held at **The Piano** in Armagh St Central Christchurch.

Christchurch is the second largest city in New Zealand and the principal city in the South Island. Founded as an English colony in 1850, it has strong links to its colonial heritage. While a number of heritage buildings were damaged and lost in the 2011 earthquake, many have or are being lovingly restored. As well as being a modern liveable city, it's the ideal gateway for vacation adventures throughout the stunning South Island.

Christchurch has been the departure point for Anglo- American Antarctic exploration for over a century with Robert Falcon Scott and Earnest Shackletons' expeditions departing from the port of Lyttelton early last century and more recently the American Deep Freeze Base centred at Christchurch Airport. The Antarctic Visitor Centre is a very popular tourist destination.

The meeting is being held in late summer which is amongst the best time to holiday in New Zealand with generally mild settled weather and schools having started back at the beginning of February.

As well as a stimulating academic programme, there will also be an extensive social programme for delegates and partners. Social functions will include a welcome reception at the Great Hall in The Arts Centre, Christchurch's neogothic old university, and the congress dinner at the iconic art gallery.

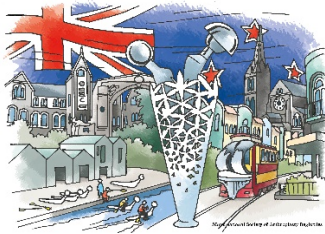
As this is a popular time to visit, be sure to book your accommodation early!

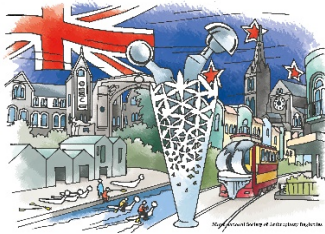
