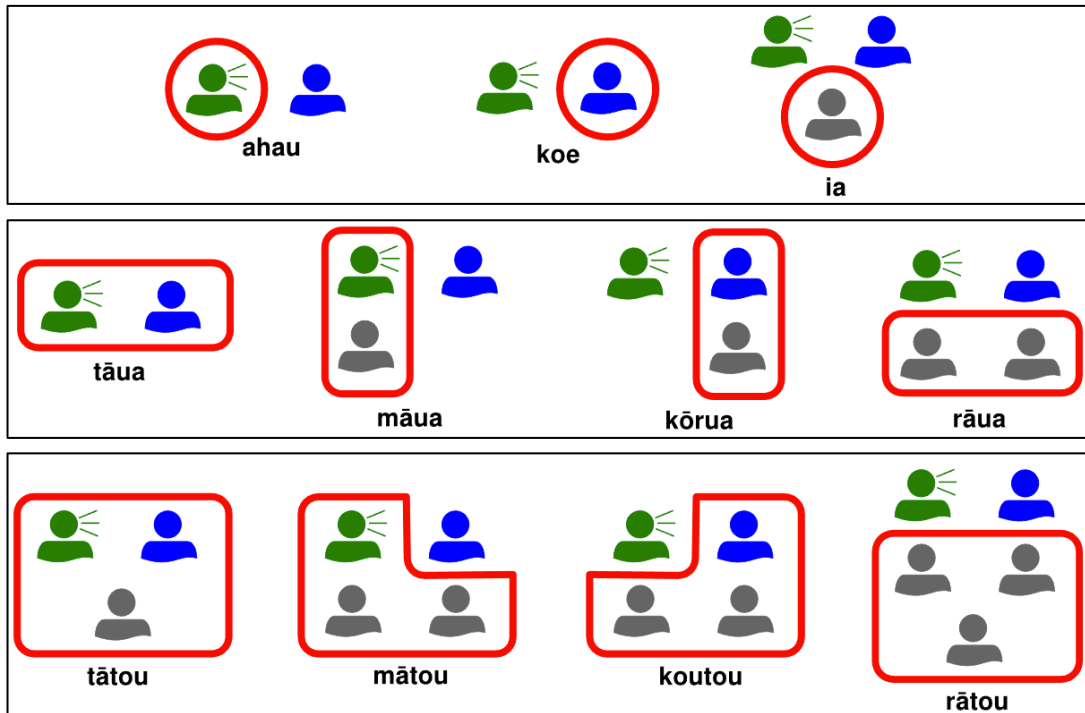

<b>2 people</b>	Māua	Kōrua	Tāua	Rāua
<b>3 or + people</b>	Mātou	Koutou	Tātou	Rātou

Single Subject + location	Meaning
Tēnei	This
Tēnā	That (near)
Tērā	That (over there)

Plural Subject + location	Meaning
Ēnei	These
Ēnā	Those (near)
Ērā	Those (over there)
